The Notes as to form and content, and all rights and obligations of the holders of the Notes and Raiffeisen Bank Hungary Zrt. as the issuer, are governed by German law, except that the provisions in connection with the status of the Notes are governed by, and shall be construed exclusively in accordance with, Hungarian law. Application will be made to list the Notes on the official list of the Luxembourg Stock Exchange and to admit the Notes to trading on the Regulated Market of the Luxembourg Stock Exchange.
